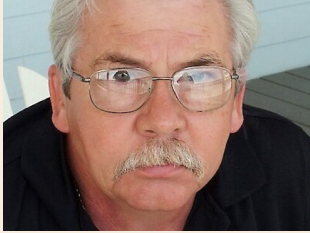


Rodney Clifford Cox (Ol Man)
