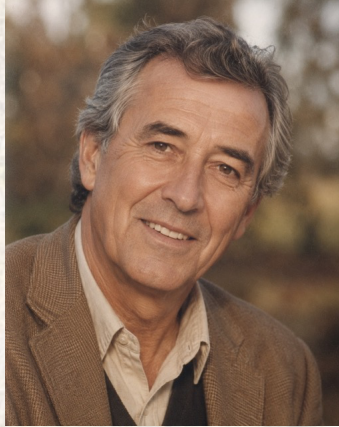


In Loving Memory

SFC Richard "Rick" Alan Carver, U.S. Army (Ret.), 77, of San Antonio, Texas, passed away on May 18, 2026.

Born September 3, 1948, in Dayton, Ohio, to Harold and Lucille Carver, he enlisted in 1966 and served honorably until 1988, with assignments at Fort Benning, Fort Bragg, and the 1st Cavalry Division. He served two tours in Vietnam and was awarded the Bronze Star, the Combat Infantryman Badge, and three Army Commendation Medals.

After his service, Rick returned to Texas, where he worked as a maintenance supervisor for the San Antonio Independent School District for 22 years. He married Linda Trevino in 1972, and they raised two sons together.

Rick remained active in the veteran community as a member of VFW Post 8541 and the American Legion, and was known for his quiet humor, his backyard smoker, and the kids' baseball teams he coached for over a decade.

He is survived by his wife Linda, his sons Daniel and Michael (Sarah), four grandchildren, and his sister Janet. He was preceded in death by his parents and his brother, Tommy.
